

Restaurants In & Around the Holiday Inn Gatwick Airport Hotel:

The Holiday Inn Gatwick Airport hotel has a nice local Old Typical English Pub/Restaurant known as very popular with our house guests. It's call the **Six Bells** located in Horley with walking distance from the hotel - They can ask in Reception for direction.

There is a local restaurant in Horley Town Centre with walking distance and takes about 10 minute walk. Taxi cost about £3.00 each way.

The Jack Fairman - Pub/Restaurant: serves local traditional English dishes at very affordable prices.

The Foresters - Pub/Restaurant: serves local traditional English dishes at very affordable prices.

Traveling from the Heathrow Airport to Gatwick Airport:

There is a bus terminal at Heathrow Airport to the Bus Station and once in the Station there should be clear signage to say which bus station number you need to catch the National Express Coach to Gatwick Airport. Alternatively there is a National Express Help Desk at the Bus Station where you can find out the time of the next Coach to Gatwick and also the Bus Stop number he needs to wait in.

Once in Gatwick Airport you need to get off at the South terminal. You need to follow the signage from the airport terminal to the hotel bus stop. You need to be in **bus stop number 12** and shuttle bus from this stop comes to the Holiday Inn. You will not miss the Holiday Inn name written on the front of the shuttle bus that goes to the Holiday Inn. The shuttle leaves every 15 minutes from Gatwick Airport to the Holiday Inn and leaves from the Holiday Inn to the Airport every 15 minutes.

Please also note that the shuttle bus does not belong to the hotel as it's an outside company providing service to the local hotels. Therefore, the shuttle charges a fee of £3.00 each way per person and payable directly to the shuttle bus driver.
